



Activity Booking Terms and Conditions

1 General Provisions

1.1 Agreement

- 1.1.1 This agreement sets out the basis of the booking for the Activity and supersedes any and all prior agreements verbal or written. Any person who is not a party to this agreement has no rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999.
- 1.1.2 These Terms will be governed in accordance with English Law and the English Courts will have non-exclusive jurisdiction to hear all disputes arising in connection with these Terms.

1.2 Booking

- 1.2.1 From our acceptance of your confirmed booking for the Activity you have 14 days to cancel your booking during which period a full refund will be made. To cancel a booking please email the published email address for the activity. Bookings made within 28 days of the Activity operating dates cannot be cancelled.

1.3 Additional Place Bookings

- 1.3.1 Additional place bookings can be made using the website, these will be subject to availability.

1.4 Payment

- 1.4.1 Payment is due at the point of booking and should be made in full by the required method to secure a booking. Only when the charges are paid in full will the booking be deemed to be confirmed and spaces be allocated to your booking.

1.5 Refunds

- 1.5.1 No refunds will be made under this agreement for the cancellation of your booking or a reduction of in the required number places you require.

1.6 Transfer of bookings

- 1.6.1 You may not transfer or assign your booking or part of your booking to any other party or person without prior written agreement of Northumberland Scouts.

1.7 Cancellation

- 1.7.1 Northumberland Scouts will endeavour to run the activity on the agreed dates. Should due to circumstances beyond our control it be necessary to cancel the Activity we will:
 - 1.7.1.1 Re-schedule the activity to different dates and transfer your booking or
 - 1.7.1.2 Cancel the Activity and provide a full refund for your payments.

1.8 Programme

- 1.8.1 Northumberland Scouts will endeavour to operate the published programme of activities but reserve the right to change the programme of activities as necessary.

1.9 Communication

- 1.9.1 Any communication to you will be made to the email address nominated at the time of booking.
- 1.9.2 Any communication to Northumberland Scouts should be made to the published email address for the Activity.

1.10 Data Protection

- 1.10.1 Each party will ensure that in the performance of its obligations under these Terms will always comply with General Data Protection Regulations
- 1.10.2 You consents to the processing by Northumberland Scouts' of your personal data for purposes connected with the Activity ('personal data' is defined in General Data Protection Regulations
- 1.10.3 You acknowledge that any data transmitted over the Internet or other transmission by electronic means cannot be guaranteed free from the risk of interception, whether encrypted or not and that Northumberland Scouts has no liability for the loss, corruption or interception of any such data.

1.11 Confidentiality

- 1.11.1 Each party shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that the other's Confidential Information to which it has access is not disclosed or distributed by its Personnel.

1.12 Liability

- 1.12.1 Except in the case of death or personal injury caused by Northumberland Scouts negligence, Northumberland Scouts or its Personnel will not be liable to you for any loss of any type (including loss or damage suffered by the you as a result of any action brought by a third party).

- 1.12.2 Except in the case of death or personal injury caused by Northumberland Scouts' negligence, notwithstanding the provisions of clauses 1.12.1 the absolute total liability of Northumberland Scouts' for any Loss suffered by the you as a result of such failure to provide the Activities will not exceed the value of your booking paid to us.
- 1.12.3 Northumberland Scouts will have no liability under these Terms or otherwise to you arising out of any act or omission of any Third-Party provider, or fault or failure of their equipment or service or other matter beyond Northumberland Scouts' control.

1.13 Permissions

- 1.13.1 You agree that you will seek the correct permissions for and comply with the rules applicable to the Activity.

1.14 Equipment and Property

- 1.14.1 Northumberland Scouts take no responsibility for your equipment, property or money or that of any of the participants. You should ensure that you have adequate insurance cover for the activity.

2 Definitions of the Agreement

2.1 The referral to these words in the Terms and Conditions shall have the following meanings:

- 2.1.1 **Activity** – the activity or even the booking is being made for.
- 2.1.2 **Northumberland Scouts** – Northumberland Scout Council, Registered Charity number 508681.
- 2.1.3 **You** – The person making the booking and accepting the Northumberland Scouts agreement on behalf of yourself, your section to unit, which every applies.
- 2.1.4 **Personnel** – Employees or volunteers of Northumberland Scouts or your Section/Unit.
