

Due to the current outbreak of Covid-19 (Coronavirus), we want to assure you that we currently have no plans to cancel Carnival Marra. The Marra Team have assessed the situation and want to assure you of the measures we are taking:

Before the Camp, the Marra Team:

- Will keep up-to-date information on our event website relating to the status of the event, and precautions for attendees onsite
- Will send email communications to registered Group Leaders with any relevant updates leading up to the event

On-site, the Marra Team will:

- Provide sanitation stations across the Camp with alcohol-based hand sanitiser
- Provide signage onsite encouraging attendees to:
 - Cover their mouth and nose with a flexed elbow or tissue (not hands) when coughing or sneezing
 - Avoid touching your hands, nose, and mouth to avoid transferring germs from surfaces
 - Discard a used tissue immediately into a closed rubbish bin
 - Wash their hands frequently with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based sanitiser
- Provide signage to encourage attendees to maintain Social Distancing
- Regularly sanitise all surfaces in communal areas
- Sanitise speaker microphones between each speaker's use

Throughout the event we encourage all Participants, Leaders, Staff and Suppliers to:

- Adopt a no-handshake policy
- Wash hands frequently
- Cough or sneeze into elbows only
- Stay home if they are sick or experiencing any cold/flu-like symptoms for their own safety and the safety of others
- Seek medical care right away and alert our staff at Event Control should they begin to experience cold or flu-like symptoms (fever, cough, trouble breathing) onsite.
